Each of the last few years, residents responded to surveys expressing an overwhelming priority for issues relative to safety and quality of life; these priorities will continue to inform the Board's work this year. The APNA continues work to improve performance from private security providers including off-duty Sheriff's Deputies, and is always working to maximize services for which we pay.

Your membership support is more important than ever – our goal is to expand service coverage but without increased membership we may eventually have to reduce coverage given significant price increases in recent years. Roughly 90% of all dues payments received are used for direct services contracted with security professionals. The remaining budget is used for communications to keep community members in the loop on our work and important happenings in the area.

In 2023 we hosted our first annual Neighborhood Night Out event with a Park-to-Park walk; and we devoted board volunteer resources to encourage and assist residents in implementing Neighborhood Watch programs with neighbors to ensure we are all looking out for each other. If you have not yet started a Neighborhood Watch group with your immediate neighbors and are still interested in doing so, please note in your comments above and provide your contact information.
